Dear Colleagues,

Last week our Chair, Professor Pete Higgins, announced the decision by the Board of Trustees to repay the outstanding amount of just over £1.9M on the Coronavirus Business Interruption Loan Scheme (CBILS), this was completed today. He also gave details of our annual pay award for next year. Both of these are significant milestones.

As we emerge from the pandemic, being able to shake off the last vestiges of it in the form of the CBILS loan marks a significant achievement, not only does it show that we are no longer reliant upon the loan, but it also gives a sense of our confidence in the future. The same can be said about the pay award. In 2018, we began a significant cost savings exercise which led, effectively, to a pay freeze for some years.

We now believe that we are in a position to not only comply with our 2017 pay policy, but also to revise it upwards to reflect where we believe we should sit in relation to our competitors and where we should invest regarding you, our staff team. We are here because of the loyalty of our customers to our products and to you. Consistently, in customer feedback, the quality of our staff is cited as a reason for returning and choosing the Field Studies Council. I know that it has been challenging but your commitment, support and passion for what the Field Studies Council stands for is what has got us to this point. Thank you for all that you have done.
